that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic feet per second, subject to the provisions of paragraph 33 of said decree and all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 12 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter and 8 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Fourteen Township Two North, Range Thirty-two East of Willamette Meridian, in Umatilla County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
