that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 cubic foot per second per acre irrigated to June 1 and 1/80 cubic foot per second per acre thereafter; further limited to one acre-foot per calendar month to June 1 and four acre-feet per acre during season April 1 to Sept. 30, measured at point of diversion. -for irrigation A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

10.0 acres in SWASWA 30.0 acres in SEASWA Section 23, 10.0 acres in NWANEA 20.0 acres in NEANWA 5.0 acres in NWANWA 5.0 acres in SEANWA Section 26, T: 19 S., R. 31 E., W. M.

Domestic and Municipal - 3.0 cubic feet per second
