and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Grant County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 15, at page 161; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1876

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from April 1 to Sept. 30; further limited to one acrefoot per acre per calendar month to July 1 and 3/4 acre-foot per acre thereafter; total five acre-feet per acre for season, measured at point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

20.0 acres in NEINE 13.0 acres in NWINE 125.3 acres in SWINE 137.7 acres in SEINE 14.5 acres in NEISE 15.5 acres in NEISE 15. Section 25. T. 13 S., R. 30 E., W. M.

3.3 acres in SW4SW4 Section 19, 1.3 acres in NW4W4 Section 30, T. 13 S., R. 31 E., W. M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
