CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That B. R. McHALEY

of P.O. Box 51, Prairie City , State of Oregon , has a right to the use of

the waters of John Day River

for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Grent County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 15., at page 451; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1869

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from April:1 to Septi. 30; further limited to one acrestoot per acre per calendar month to July Land 3/4 acrestoot per acre thereafter; total five acresteet per acre for season; measured at point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant

(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

25.2 acres in SWASEL 25.0 acres in SELSEL Section 2, 16.0 acres in NWANEL 4.8 acres in NELNWA Section 11, T. 13 S., R. 33 E., W. M.

(NOTE: This land has a supplemental supply from Slaughter House Gulch under numerous urmamed ditches with priority of 1872.)

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
