CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That DAVE INGRAM

of Pendleton, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Birch Creek, a tributary of the Umatilla River,

for the purpose of the irrigation of 20 acres of land, domestic and stock use,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Park House of the State of Oregon, in Volume 7, at puge 127; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1872

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose's aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose's, and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic feet per second, subject to the provisions of paragraph 33 of mid decree and all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is us follows: 12 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter and 7 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Thirty-three, Township Two North, Range Thirty-two and 1 acre in the northeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Four, Township One North, Range Thirty-two, all East of Willamette Meridian, in Umatilla County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesuid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
