for the purpose of the irrigation of 23 acres of land, domestic and stock use,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 127; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1904

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.29 cubic feet per second, subject to the provisions of paragraph 33 of said decree and all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appartenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 23 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Nine, Township One South, Range Thirty-two East of Willamette Meridian, in Umatilla County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water uforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
