CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Grant County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 15, at page 461; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from February 15, 1889

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 cubic foot per second per acre irrigated to June 1 and 1/80 cubic foot per second per acre thereafter: further limited to one acre-foot per calendar month to June 1 and four acrefeet per acre during season April 1 to Sept. 30; measured at point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

> 7.5 acres in SWANE 5.7 acres in NELNWI 3.3 acres in NW NW 21.3 acres in SEHNW 11.0 acres in NEASWA 8.3 acres in NWASEA Section 12, T. 13 S., R. 27 E., W. M.

The land in the NELNWL, 14.3 acres in the SELNWL, NELSWL and 4 acres in NWASEL have a supplemental supply from John Day River pumped thru the Pump Ditch with priority of 1906.)

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
