CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That ROB'T MORRISON of Adams State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Wild Horse Creek, a tributary of the Umatilla River,

for the purpose of Domestic use,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 3, at page 127 ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1902

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose and shall not exceed

A description of the lands situated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: The Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Three, Township Three North, Range Thirty-four East of Willamette Meridian, in Umatilla County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
