


CERTIFICATE

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That E. P. BUCHANAN,

Sisters. State of Oregon, has a right to the use of SQUAW CREEK, a tributary of the Deschutes River, in Crook County, the waters of Oregon,


for the purpose of irrigation, (during the irrigation season)

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Crook Oregon for County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Board of Control of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose , and shall not exceed 1.4 cubic feet per second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

14 acres in \mathbb{N}_{2}^{-1} of \mathbb{S}_{2}^{-1} ; 12 acres in \mathbb{N}_{2}^{-1} of \mathbb{S}_{2}^{-1} ; 23 acres in \mathbb{S}_{2}^{-1} of \mathbb{S}_{2}^{-1} ; and 21 acres in SE4 of SE4; Section 4, Tp. 15 S. R. 10 E., W. M., in Crook County, Oregon.



The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
