4 cubic feet per second from Dry Gulch

4 cubic feet per second from Spring Creek

4 cubic feet per second from Salmon Creek

2 cubic feet per second from Lightning Creek

1 cubic foot per second from Olive Creek

(NOTE: Water for mining used entire year.)

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
