CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **EMMA L. VELVIN**

of **Prairie City**, State of **Oregon**, has a right to the use of
the waters of **John Day River and Warm Spring in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 18, T. 13 S., R. 34 E., WM**
for the purpose of **Irrigation**

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Grant County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume **15**, at page **461**; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from **1868 for 10.0 acres from John Day River thru Dodson Ditch**
1870 for 11.7 acres from John Day River thru Tucker Ditch
1876 for 24.0 acres from Warm Spring thru Warm Springs Ditch

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

23.9 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
9.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
9.4 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
25.8 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
40.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
35.6 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 7,
5.0 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 18,
T. 13 S., R. 34 E., W. M.

John Day River:

1/40 cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from April 1 to Sept. 30; further
limited to one acre-foot per acre per calendar month to July 1 and 3/4 acre-foot
per acre thereafter; total five acre-feet per acre for season, measured at point
of diversion.

Warm Spring:

1/40 cubic foot per second per acre irrigated to June 1 and 1/80 cubic foot per
second per acre thereafter; further limited to one acre-foot per calendar month
to June 1 and four acre-feet per acre during season April 1 to Sept. 30, measured
at point of diversion.

(NOTE: Acreage irrigated from each ditch is not
segregated.)

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
