CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **VELDA WILLIAMS**

of **Mt. Vernon**, State of **Oregon**, has a right to the use of
the waters of **Ingle Creek and John Day River**
for the purpose of **Irrigation and Supplemental Irrigation**

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Grant County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume **15**, at page **461**; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from **1882**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **1/40** cubic foot per
second per acre irrigated to June 1 and **1/80** cubic foot per second per acre there-
after; further limited to one acre-foot per calendar month to June 1 and four acre-
feet per acre during season April 1 to Sept. 30, measured at point of diversion.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

4.0 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 28,
T. 13 S., R. 30 E., W. M.

(NOTE: This land has a supplemental supply from John Day River with
a priority of 1902.)

The limitation for John Day River is: **1/40** cubic foot per second
per acre irrigated from April 1 to Sept. 30; further limited to one
acre-foot per acre per calendar month to July 1 and **3/4** acre-foot
per acre thereafter; total five acre-feet per acre for season,
measured at point of diversion.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
