that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Swi SEi. Section 14. Township 1 North, Range 4 West, W.M.: 10 chs. N. & 26 chs. W. from SE corner of Sec. 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other of one cubic foot per second right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 21 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 1.4 acres SWE SEE Section 14 Township 1 North, Range 4 West, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
