for the purposes of irrigation and domestic use, (irrigation during the irrigation season)

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Crook Oregon for County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Board of Control of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 120; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1901;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose a aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose s, and shall not exceed .44 cubic feet per second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

12 acres in Swa of NE ; and 10 acres in SE4 of NE ; Section 24, Tp. 14 S. R. 10 E., W. M., in Crook County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
