CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That S. H. ROCKWELL

of Pendleton State of Oregon 97801 has a right to the use of
the waters of Birch Creek and McKay Creek, tributaries of the Umatilla River,

for the purpose of the irrigation of 25 acres of land, domestic and stock use,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of
Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem,
in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume-³ 1, at
page 127 ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1894 for
Tract No. 1, and 1894 for Tract No. 2.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the
purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said pur-
pose and shall not exceed 0.32 cubic feet per second, subject to the provisions
of paragraph 33 of said decree and all other conditions and limitations contained
in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water
hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water
is put to beneficial use, is as follows: Tract No. 1: ^{From Birch Creek,} 2 acres in the Northeast quarter
of Northwest quarter of Section Twenty-two, and 8 acres in the Southeast quarter of
Southwest quarter of Section Fifteen, Township One North, Range Thirty-two East of
Willamette Meridian, in Umatilla County, Oregon.

Tract No. 2: ^{From McKay Creek,} 5 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter and
10 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Twenty-six Township
One North, Range Thirty-two East of Willamette Meridian, in Umatilla County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the
lands or place of use herein described.
