CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOHN DEININGER

of Route 5, Box 606, Oregon City, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of unnamed spring flow and Clear Creek, tributary of Clackamas River, appropriated under Application No. 29998, Permit No. 23421,

for the purposes of irrigation,

under Reservoir Permit No. R-1715 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 31, 1955.

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 2.5 acre feet.

The reservoir is located in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Connell DIC #56, Section 31, Township 2 South, Range 3 East, W.M.
