# CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is To Certify, That** HENRY ZORN

of Route 1, Aurora, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Mission Creek and Champoeg Creek a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation of 334.0 acres from Champoeg Cr., 3.8 acres from Mission Cr. & suppl. irrigation of 17.3 acres from Mission Creek under Permit No. 19380 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 12, 1950.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.76 cubic feet per second; being 1.5 cubic feet per second from Champoeg Creek and 0.26 cubic foot per second from Mission Creek,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> & SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> as projected within R. Newell DLC #43, Section 1; NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> & NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> as projected within R. Newell DLC #43, Section 2; NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> as projected within John Goodell DLC #91, Section 11; NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> as projected within R. Newell DLC #43, Section 12; all in Township 4 South, Range 2 West, W.M. The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

**This Is to Certify, That** M. J. and H. T. LOONEY

of Tangent, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Lake Creek a tributary of Calapooya River for the purpose of irrigation of 28.4 acres,

under Permit No. 19456 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 28, 1950,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.35 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  as projected within Ingraham DLC #40, Section 2, Township 12 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
