CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FLOYD L. SHORTRIDGE

of Rt. 1 S., Box 782, Glen Flora Bogs, Bandon, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Davis Creek & Shortridge Reservoir const. under Appl. No. R-29421, Per. No. R-1656 a tributary of Crooks Lake for the purpose of irrigation of 3.92 acres,

under Per-mit No. 23061 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 12, 1954,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 13, Township 30 South, Range 15 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre, if for the irrigation of cranberries, shall be limited to one-tenth of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.75 acre foot for each acre irrigated in any 30-day period and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 6 acre feet per acre during the irrigation season of each year, from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1656. If for the irrigation of any other crop, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of _____ and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 30 South, Range 15 West, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

S. 66° 37' E. 466.8 ft.; th. along the W. boundary of the State Highway S. 11° 40' W., 457.5 ft.; th. along said W. boundary S. 13° 25' W. 368.7 ft.; th. N. 75° 00' W. 320.0 ft.; th. S. 02° 00' W. 170.1 ft.; th. N. 43° 47' W. 229.3 ft.; th. N. 53° 41' W. 106.5 ft.; th. N. 67° 48' W. 73.7 ft.; th. N. 75° 00' W. 159.4 ft. to the W. boundary of the said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$; th. N. 769.4 ft. to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
