CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. W. and LELA WATSON

of 180 West Herford, Gladstone, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed spring a tributary of Clackamas River by way of Thimble Cr. & Abernathy Cr. for the purpose of domestic use 1 family,

under Permit No. 24952 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 18, 1957,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Williams DLC #56, Section 10, Township 3 South, Range 2 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 4 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 3
Township 3 South, Range 2 East, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:
Beg. at a point 3 chs. E. and S. 89° 50' E. 401.5 ft. from the quarter section corner between Sections 3 and 10, in T. 3 S., R. 2 E., W.M., which beginning point is the SE corner of that tract of land conveyed in book 408, page 88, Deed Records to Roland Joe Morris and Mary Morris, husband and wife, from said beginning point running thence N. 500.00 ft. to an iron pipe; running thence S. 89° 50' E. a distance of 464.00 ft. to a point; running thence S. 500.00 ft. to a point, which bears S. 89° 50' E. 464.00 ft. from the place of beginning; running thence N. 89° 50' W. 464.00 ft. to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
