CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That EUGENE W. ANDERSON

of Trail, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Trail Creek a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation of 0.27 acres,

under Permit No. 25510 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 19, 1958,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 17, Township 33 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.27 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 17
Township 33 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Commencing at the quarter sec. cor. on the N. boundary of Sec. 17, T. 33 S., R. 1 W., W.M.; and running th. E. along the N. line of said sec., 1620 ft. to a point on the center line of the Tiller-Trail Highway, the true point of beginning; th. S. along the center line of said highway, 600 ft.; th. E. 300 ft., more or less to the center line of Trail Creek; th. Northerly along the center line of Trail Creek, 671 ft., more or less, to the N. line of said sec., th. W. along the N. line of said sec., 600 ft., more or less to the true point of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
