## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That CHAS. H. BARTHOLOMEW

of Galloway State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Little Butter Creek (West Fork), tributary of the Umatilla River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 144 acres of land, domestic and stock use,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Crder Record of the Intermediate of the State of Oregon, in Volume 3, at page 250; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1868 for 0.59 cubic feet per second, and 1898 for 2.18 cubic feet per second,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose saforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.77 cubic feet per second, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree,

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 30 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 19 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Twentyone; 6 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter; 28 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 28 acres in the Southeast quarter of the Northwest of acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter; 22 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter; and 30 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Sixteen, Township One North, Range Twenty-seven East of Willamette Meridian, in Morrow County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
