for the purpose of the irrigation of 178.1 acres of land, domestic and stock use,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State Witter Rolling of the State of Oregon, in Volume 47 at page 250; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1884 for 1.35 cubic feet per second; 1895 for 1.17 cubic feet per second, and 1904 for 1.11 cubic feet per second;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and bereby confirmed for the purpose suforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose s, and shall not exceed 3.61 cubic feet per second, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrighted under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appartenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 40 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter; 8.5 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter; 20.5 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter; 28.5 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast qua
