## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

SHIPLEY AND SELMA TROTTER

of

Tygh Valley

, State of Oregon

, has a right to the use of

the waters of Badger Creek, a tributary of White River

for the purpose of irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wasco County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 7, at page 196; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1879;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed three acre feet per acre curing any irrigation season (with further limitations contained in paragraph 24 of said decree).

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

11 acres in the SE NE Township 4 South, Range 13 East, W. M.

NOTE: Certificate of water right issued to W. J. Knox and recorded at page 5752, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of water for irrigation and the development of power. Subsequently, the right for the development of power was canceled by order of the State Engineer entered March 30, 1957, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 543.730. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to W. J. Knox.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
