that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.23 cubic foot per second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

16 acres in the SW SW SW Section 14,

Township 38 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

NOTE: Certificate of water right issued to John Frederick Bergesch and recorded at page 16428, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of water for irrigation and placer mining. Subsequently, the right for placer mining was canceled by order of the State Engineer entered April 3, 1959, pursuant to the provisions of CRS 540.621. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to John Frederick Bergesch.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
