that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 50 acre feet stored water only.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE_4^1 Niv_4^1 , Section 10, Township 35 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of processing feet per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and shall be further limited to a total diversion of not to exceed 50 acre feet per year.
