CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOSEPH DOBER

of Route 2, Cornelius, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of Davis Creek, tributary of Tualatin River, appropriated under Application No. 28558, Permit No. 22803,

for the purposes of
 irrigation,

under Reservoir Permit No. R-1589 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 23, 1953 for 28.8 acre feet and November 25, 1953 for 38.7 acre feet,

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 67.5 acre feet.

The reservoir is located in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ & SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 26; NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ & SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 27, Township 1 South, Range 3 West, W.M.
