CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That STATE OF OREGON,
BOARD OF FORESTRY

of Salem, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Arbor Cr., Galloway Cr. & res. const. under Per. No. R-704 a tributary of Bowers Slough for the purpose of irrigation of 22.4 acres and domestic use in arboretum,

under Permit No. 23591 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 27, 1955,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.30 cubic foot per second; being 0.28 cubic foot per second from Galloway Creek and reservoir for irrigation and 0.02 cubic foot per second from Arbor Creek for domestic,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ & SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 36, Township 10 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-704,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

19.2 acres Lot 1 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
3.2 acres Lot 2 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
domestic SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Reed DLC #57
domestic NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Reed DLC #57
Section 31
Township 10 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
