of Echo State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Butter Creek, a tributary of the Umatilla River,

for the purpose of the irrigation of 96.5 acres of land, domestic and stock use,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State water Board of the State of Oregon, in Volume 47, at page 250; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1870

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.60 cubic feet per second, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 18 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter; 33 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter; 12 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter and  $3\frac{1}{2}$  acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Five, and 30 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Eight, Township Three North, Range Twenty-eight East of Willamette

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
