CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HAROLD D. FIFER, Route 4, Box 303

of Grants Pass, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Grays Creek, a tributary of Applegate River
for the purpose of irrigation of 12 acres and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from August 18, 1877;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.20 cubic foot per
second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

0.1 acre in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
7.7 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 20,
3.0 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
1.2 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 29,
Township 37 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

NOTE: This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use of water
approved by orders of the State Engineer entered July 17, 1957 and March
18, 1960, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530, and supersedes
certificate of water right issued to Protected Cove Orchards and recorded at
page 16284, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
