CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CCN TAYLOR

of 39 J. Street North, Lakeview, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of 4 unnamed streams and 4 reservoirs const. under Appl. No. R-27961, Per. No. R-1481 a tributary of Thomas Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 180.2 acres.

under Permit No. 22111 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 29, 1952.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 4.50 cubic feet per second, being 2.0 cubic feet per second from Stream #1, 0.5 cubic foot per second from Stream #2, 1.0 cubic foot per second from Stream #3, and 1.0 cubic foot per second from Stream #4.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Streams #1 & #2 - NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$; Stream #3 - NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 26; Stream #4 - SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$; Section 27; Township 37 South, Range 20 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1481.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
