and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Representation of the State of Oregon, in Volume K at 250 ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1877

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.51 cubic feet per second, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows. 9 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 54 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter; 20 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter; 0.5 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Fifteen; 4 acros in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter; 22 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter; 53.5 acres in the Southwest quar ter of Southwest quarter and 16 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Fourteen; 12.5 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 39 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter; 9 acres in the Northwest quarter of North west quarter and 13 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Twenty-three, Township One North, Range Twenty-seven, East of Willamette Meridian, in Morrow County, Oregon.
