CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That ADELAIDE R. MCKENNON (Robt.S.French, Agt)

of La Grande, State of Oregon 97850 has a right to the use of the waters of MILL CREEK, a tributary of Catherine Creek and the Grande Ronde River in Union County, State of Oregon

for the purpose of irrigation from May 1st to September 1st of each year and domestic use throughout the year, said domestic use being included within the amount of water allowed for irrigation during the irrigation season.

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State Water Board of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 207;

that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1897 for domestic use and from 1870 for irrigation

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed .08 cubic feet per second as of date 1870.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 6 acres in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 21, Township 3 South, Range 40 East of Willamette Meridian, in Union County, Oregon.

(NOTE: This certificate is issued to correct and supercede that certain certificate issued to the above named party on May 1, 1912, and recorded in Vol. 1 Page 371 of State Record of Water Right certificates, and on page 20 in Vol. 1, Water right certificates for Union County, wherein the land was described as being in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 21, T 3 S. R. 40 E., when it should have been described as being in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of said section, Township and Range)

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That ALTHOUSE MINING CO., a corporation, 961 -8th Street, of Oakland, State of California has a right to the use of the waters of Althouse Creek, a tributary of the Illinois River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 20 acres of land and mining from November to July

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State Water Board of the State of Oregon, in Volume 4, at page 427; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1898 for Tract No. 1 and 1898 for Tract No. 2

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.4 cubic feet per second for irrigation and 4 cubic feet per second for mining, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: Tract No. 1: 20 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter and Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Five, Township Forty South, Range Seven West of Willamette Meridian, in Josephine County, Oregon.

Tract No. 2: Placer mines are located in the South half of Section Five and Northwest quarter of Section Eight, Township Forty South, Range Seven West of Willamette Meridian, in Josephine County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
