CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That HILA A. C. HOUCK

of Kerby, State of Oregon has a right to the use of  
the waters of Althouse Creek, a tributary of the Illinois River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 128 acres of land, domestic and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order  
Record of the State Water Board of the State of Oregon, in Volume 4, at page 427;  
that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1856 for 100 acres and 1895 for  
28 acres

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes  
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  
2.56 cubic feet per second, and shall be subject to all other conditions and  
limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby con-  
firmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use,  
is as follows: 39 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter; 10 acres in  
the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Thirteen, Township Forty  
South, Range Eight; 3 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter; 30  
acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter; 36 acres in the Southwest  
quarter of Northwest quarter and 6 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest  
quarter of Section Eighteen, Township Forty South, Range Seven, All West of Wil-  
lamette Meridian, in Josephine County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or  
place of use herein described.
