CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That MARY ELLEN LEONARD

of Kerby, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Althouse Creek, a tributary of the Illinois River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 48 acres of land, domestic and stock use, and placer mining November to July

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State Water Board of the State of Oregon, in Volume 4, at page 427; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1858 for Tract No. 1 and 1858 for Tract No. 2

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.96 cubic feet per second for irrigation and 4 cubic feet per second for mining, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: Tract No. 1: 13 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 24 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter and 11 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Four, Township Forty South, Range Seven West of Willamette Meridian, in Josephine County, Oregon.

Tract No. 2: Emerald Tunnel Gold Placer claims and placer ground situated in SE 1/4 and SW 1/4 of Section 4 and NE 1/4 of Section 9 and NE 1/4 and NW 1/4 of Section 4, Township 40 South, Range 7 West of Willamette Meridian, in Josephine County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
