that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1876

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.26 cubic feet per second, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use,

is as follows: 35 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter; 10 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter; 10 acres in Lot Three in Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Seven: 4 acres in Lot Three in Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter and 4 acres in Lot Four in Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Eighteen, Township Forty South, Range Seven West of Willamette Meridian, in Josephine County, Oregon.
