A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 30 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Seven, Township Forty South, Range Seven West of Willamette Meridian, in Josephine County, Oregon.
