a tributary of Miller Creek (Lost River) irrigation of 12.8 acres

under Permit No. U-228 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 7. 1948.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.16 cubic feet per second.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE's SE's, Section 30. Township 39 South, Range 13 East. W.M., 18 chs. W. & 2 chs. N. of SE cor., Section 30.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per-acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be limited to a to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from March 1st to September 30th of each year. Well shall be so cased as to prevent loss of underground water.

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

4.0 acres NET NET 8.8 acres SET NET Section 31
Township 39 South, Range 13 East, W.M.

The  $rig^{i,y}$  to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
