CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That P. J. and JOSIE M. KIRCHGESTNER

of Route 2, Freewater , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a well a tributary of Johnson Creek (Walla Walla River) for the purpose of irrigation

under Permit No. U-229 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 8, 1948

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.27 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW4 NEW, Section 30. Township 6 North, Pange 35 East, W.M.; 23.0 chains S. and 21.3 chains W. from the NE corner of Section 30.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 0.0375 cubic afericantation for per second perfects or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

15.6 acres SW/ NE/4 Section 30

Section 30
Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beg. at a point on the N. line 21 rods E. of the NW corner of the SWA of the NEA of Sec. 30, running th. E. 59 rods, more or less to the center of the NEA of said Sec. 30, th. S. 44 rods and 14.8 ft.; th. W. 59 rods, more or less, to a point 21 rods E. of the W. line of the NEA of said Sec. 30, th. N. 44 rods and 14.8 feet to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
