CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

**This is to Certify, That** C. A. TREFATHEN  
of Holland, State of Oregon has a right to the use of  
the waters of The Run, a tributary of Althouse Creek

for the purpose of Mining November to July

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order  
Record of the State Water Board of the State of Oregon, in Volume 4, at page 427;  
that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1859

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes  
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  
4 cubic feet per second, and shall be subject to all other conditions and  
limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby con-  
firmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use,  
is as follows: The Democrat Mining Claim, in Section Four, Township Forty South,  
Range Seven West of Willamette Meridian, in Josephine County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or  
place of use herein described.
