CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That W. D. HUNT of Kerby, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Althouse Creek, a tributary of the Illinois River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 40 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State Water Board of the State of Oregon, in Volume 4, at page 427; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1900

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.8 cubic feet per second, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 5 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter; 20 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Twenty-seven; 5 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter and 10 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Thirty-four, Township Thirty-nine South, Range Eight West of Willamette Meridian, in Josephine County, Oregon.
