CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MRS. THUMAN F. DONALDSON

of 2109 Fortola Drive, Grants Pass , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River a tributery of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of irrigation of 0.4 acre,

under Permit No. 24116 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 16, 1956

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 3 (NEW SWM), Section 21, Township 36 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.4 acre Lot 3 (NEW SWM)
Section 21
Township 36 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

The land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the S. line of Portola Drive, said point being 30 ft. S. and 215.6 ft. W. of the center of Sec. 21, T.36S., R.5W., W.M., in

Josephine County, which is the point of beginning; run th. W. 16 ft.; th. S.
282.3 ft. to the center of a concrete irrigation ditch; th. along the center of said ditch N. 74°19' W. a distance of 87.2 ft.; th. S. 481.4 ft. more or less, to the Rogue River; th. Northeasterly along Rogue River to a point directly S. of the true point of beginning; th. N. 730 ft. more or less to the true point of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
