CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That FRANCIS O'NEILL

of Vale, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Cottonwood Creek, a tributary of Bully Creek

for the purpose of the irrigation of 120 acres of land from April 1st to September 1st domestic and stock use during all the year

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State Water Board of the State of Oregon, in Volume 4, at page 385; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1883

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2 1/2 cubic feet per second, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 40 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter; 40 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter and 40 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Nine, Township Eighteen South, Range Forty-three East of Willamette Meridian, in Malheur County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
