to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
Fall Creek & Carnes Creek,
a tributary of Alsea River for the purpose of

operation of fish hatchery & domestice use 2 families,

under Permit No. 22807 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 30, 1952.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 22.0 cubic feet per second; being 20.0 cubic feet per second from Fall Creek & 1.99 cubic feet per second from Carnes Creek for hatchery, & 0.01 cubic foot per second from Carnes Creek for domestic use.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SWA SEA SWA, Section 26, Township 13 South Range 9 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to \_\_\_\_ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

fish culture & domestic, SE<sup>1</sup> SW<sup>1</sup> Section 26
fish culture, NE<sup>1</sup> NW<sup>1</sup> Section 35
Township 13 South, Range 9 West, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
