CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That OREGON STATE FISH COMMISSION

of 307 State Office Building, Portland 1, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Fall Creek

a tributary of Alsea River for the purpose of fish culture & maintenance of Fall Creek Ponds constructed under Application No. R-29592, Permit No. R-1696,

under Permit No. 23303 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 3, 1954,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW¹/₄ SE¹/₄, Section 26, Township 13 South, Range 9 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

fish culture, SE¹/₄ SW¹/₄
Section 26
fish culture, NE¹/₄ NW¹/₄
Section 35
Township 13 South, Range 9 West, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
