CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify. That G. H. STRICKLAND

, State of Oregon of West Linn , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Willamette River a tributary of Columbia River

irrigation of 0.5 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit Vo. 24559 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 9, 1956

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an a meaning actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW4 SE4 as projected within Burns DLC 51, Section 30, Township 2 South, Range 2 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 22 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 0.5 acres SWA SEA Section 30 as projected within Burns DLC 51 Township 2 South, Range 2 East, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows: Beginning at an iron pipe set in the northeasterly boundary of Tract 9, which is N. 18°26' W. 279.61 feet from the most easterly corner of said Tract 9; thence N. 67°57' W. 28.54 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 23°59' W. 42.60 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 44°26' E. 28.76 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 44°35' W. 49.60 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 48°26' E. 311.00 feet, more or less, to the southeasterly boundary line of said Tract 9; thence N. 24°44' E. 132.535 feet, to the most easterly corner of said Tract 9; thence N. 48°26' W. 279.61 feet to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
