CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DR. JOSEPH R. GIBSON

of Watrous Building Forest Grove, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed creek a tributary of Gales Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 6.1 acres

under Permit No. 23239 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 10, 1954

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Wm. Beagle DLC 38, Section 3, Township 1 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

6.1 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 3
as projected within Wm. Beagle DLC 38
Township 1 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

Land on which water is to used is part of that described as follows:

That part of the following described land lying north of an unnamed stream. Beginning at the northeast corner of that certain tract of land conveyed to R. H. and Eva Irving by deed, which point is on the north line of Section 3, T. 1 S., R. 4 W., W.M. N. 89°58' W. 370.4 feet from the quarter corner of said north line, and running thence along the section line, N. 89°58' W. 195.0 feet to a point; thence S. 41°01' W. (at 19.9 feet an iron rod) a distance of 182.3 feet to an iron rod; thence S. 0°05 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' W. 1322.6 feet to an iron rod set of the south line of the said Irving property; thence N. 88°28' E. 311.6 feet to a 1" iron pipe at the southeast corner of said Irving property; thence N. 0°05 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' E. 1451.6 feet to the place of beginning, subject to the rights of public in and to the county road #845.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
