## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That EDWARD W. SOREHSON

of North Powder , "rate of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Anthony Creek a tributary of North Powder River for the purpose of

Irrigation

of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters under Permit No. 14179 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 26, 1940;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.75 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW2 NW2, Section 13, T. 6 S., R. 37 E., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one-white feet q per serve, of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated from March 1 to July 1 and 1/80th of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated from July 1 to October 1 of each year or its equivalent for each acre irrigated,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right w appurtenant, is as follows:

> 10 acres in the NET NY 40 acres in the NW NE he SW NE n 17 T. 6 S. E., W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion of water approved by an order of the State Engineer entered December 30, 1959 pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530, and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to B. F. Sorenson and recorded at page 13423, Volume 11, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
