CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That PUCKETT & SCHERER

of 120 N. 7th, Klamath Falls, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Anna Creek Slough Drain a tributary of Seven Mile Creek for the purpose of supplemental irrigation of 103 acres

under Permit No. 24666 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 6, 1957

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.29 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 4 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 6, T. 34 S., R. 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ E., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall also be limited to the water available at the proposed point of diversion, and shall not carry with it the right to compel the continuance of the waste water,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

17.6 acres Lot 7
29.8 acres Lot 8
39.4 acres Lot 9
16.2 acres Lot 10
Section 1
T. 34 S., R. 6 E., W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
