Pumped Storage Pond & storage of water appropriated under Appl. #22597, Permit
No. 23041,

hydroelectric power, *for the purposes of*
under Reservoir Permit No. R-1640 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said
waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right
hereby confirmed dates from June 23, 1954,

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes afore-
said, shall not exceed 345 acre feet,
