nt page 351 , on the 14th day of April, 1920 ; that the priority of
the right hereby confirmed dates from October 19, 1916 ; that the amount of
water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, a is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not
exceed 0.015 cubic feet per second., or its equivalent in case of rotation. The thereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State off: A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby
confirmed is appartenent, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 1.25 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southwest
quarter of Section Four, Township Thirty-nine South, Range One East of Willamette Meridian, in Jackson County, Oregon.
The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
